

Helping to Save Lives at Ysgol Rhiwabon

In partnership with the Welsh Governments "Save a life Cymru" campaign, Ysgol Rhiwabon have secured an Automated External Defibrillator (AED). Together with an external cabinet, this will form part of the PADS strategy to improve out of hospital cardiac arrest in Wales. The school will support the wider community by placing the cabinet in an area that is accessible to the wider community 24 hours a day all year round.



To this end we have located the cabinet and AED to the rear of the school by the left hand side of the main sports centre entrance doors. It is available 24 hours a day / 365 days a year to all the community.

We have registered the AED on the Welsh Ambulance Command and Control database and it is live.
