URGENT!!

Firstly: I have to comment that the reaction to the following information has been overwhelming from individuals and groups in **OUR** community:

Vicar, Kate Tiltman has issued the following statement:

"The church will be open every day from Sunday if people wish to come in and pray. There will be a board to write the names of people who need our prayers. There will also be space to write the names of anyone in the community who needs a phone call or shopping done, and the **Church** is working **WITH Friends of Ruabon** to ensure that the vulnerable in our community are cared for

Secondly: COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS

Community volunteers are now required over the coming weeks to support the public services in various roles within the local community, to support public services during the Coronavirus Pandemic, i.e.

1. **Child Care**
2. **Admin**

3. Cooking;
4. Befrienders;
5. Delivery drivers;
6. Shoppers;
7. Visitors to check on neighbours;
8. Dog Walkers.

These roles will be dependent upon local requirements and in relation to the current Covid19 situation and as it develops.

All skills and experience will be considered.

Main requirements are a desire to help and offer support in your community.

Thirdly

The Events in Ruabon Cancelled - so far:

1. All group and public meetings arranged by the church are cancelled until further notice; this includes Confirmation Classes.
However, Weddings can go ahead, but are restricted to 10 people (including the Bride and Groom.)
This measure does not include the Catholic Church yet, which shares with the Anglican Church.
2. Friends of Ruabon has cancelled the Litter Pick scheduled for Saturday 28th February and the Spring Fayre which was due to take place at the Village Hall on Saturday 4th April.
Not sure about the Bunny Hunt as this is scheduled to take place outside and behind the Park Gates.
