To make a sentence negative just add 'ddim'

Es i ddim - I didn't go

Est ti ddim - You didn't go

Aeth e/o ddim - He didn't go

Aeth Sam ddim - Sam didn't go

Aeth fy ffrindiau a fi ddim - My friends and I didn't go

Aethon ni ddim - We didn't go

Aethoch chi ddim - You didn't go

Aethon nhw ddim - They didn't go

Gwnes i - I did/made

Gwnes ti - You did/made

Gwnaeth o/e - He did/made

Gwnaeth hi - She did/made

Gwnaeth Sam - Sam did/made

Gwnaeth fy ffrindiau a fi - My friends and I did/made

Gwaethon ni - We did/made

Gwnaethoch chi - You did/made

Gwnaethon nhw - They did/made

Ces i - I had

Cest ti - You had

Cafodd o/e - He had

Cafodd hi - She had

Cafodd Sam - Sam had

Cafodd fy ffrindiau a fi - My friends and I had

Cawson ni - We had

Cawsoch chi - You had

RHEOLAU

Rules

If a word ends in a vowel (a,e,i,o,u,w,y) : cross out the vowel and add +ais. E.g. Bwyta bwy(t)a + ais **BWYTAIS I**

If a word ends in a consonant (not a,e,i,o,u,w,y) : add +ais. E.g. Siarad Siarad + ais **SIARADAIS I**

OND!!!

There are exceptions

Siarad am rywun arall

Talking about someone else

Just add the following endings instead of -ais i to talk about others:

Bwytaist ti - You ate

Bwyttodd o/e - He ate

Bwyttodd hi - She ate

Bwyttodd Sam - Sam ate

Bwyttodd fy ffrindiau a fi - Me and my friends ate

Bwyton ni - We ate

Bwytoch chi - You ate

Bwyton nhw - They ate

Gweld Gwel +ais i
GWELAIS I
(I saw)

Chwarae Chwarae + ais i
CHWARAEAIS I
(I played)

Meddwl Meddylly + ais i
MEDDYLIAIS I
(I thought)

Mwynhau Mwynh eu +ais i
MWYNHEUAIS I
(I enjoyed)
