1. Choose a country (any country outside of the United Kingdom)
2. Draw a map of the country, including geographical features:
  - Capital city
  - 4 other major cities
  - Rivers
  - Mountain range
  - Countries that border it
  - Seas that surround it
3. Draw the flag and colour it in
4. Find any important landmarks in the country
  - List as many as you can find
  - Select three to describe
  - Include pictures
  - A video of one (even just the link)
5. The history of the country
  - Is it a monarchy or a republic? (does it have a king/queen or not?)
  - Who is in charge of the country?
  - Famous people from their past
  - Any wars they have taken part in? What happened? When?
  - When was the country formed?
  - Did anybody discover it? If yes, who and when?
  - Was it ever owned by another country? If yes, who and when?
  - Who were its indigenous people? (the native people who lived there)
  - Language spoken?
  - Is it a democracy or a dictatorship?
6. Religion
  - What religions are in the country?
  - What is the main religion?
  - Discuss the main religion
  - What is their Holy Book?
  - Who is their God?
  - What are their main moral principles? e.g. Christianity = 10 Commandments (name them)
  - Where do they worship?
  - Draw their religious symbols
  - Do they wear certain clothes?
  - Any religious festivals and/or traditions? Name them and describe them.
  - What Holy days do they have throughout the year?
