Dear Parent/ Guardian,

Year 11 Results Day, Thursday 20th August, 9am until 12 noon.

We are still awaiting formal guidance regarding the arrangements for the GCSE Examination Results Day and therefore any information in this letter is subject to change if circumstances, due to Covid19 and Social Distancing Measures, alter significantly before the published date above.

We are really looking forward to seeing our Year 11 students again on this important day. Given the unusual circumstances this year, this letter explains our proposed organisation of the day to ensure that everyone is kept safe, whilst also providing the opportunity to celebrate and support in an appropriate way.

Collection of results 9am – 12 noon

This year results will be handed out in tutor groups. If the weather is fine this will take place outside and students will be shown their collection point as they arrive from 9am onwards. In the event of poor weather, students will be asked to report to reception one at a time and they will be directed to Tutor group collection points along E corridor. On entry to school, hand sanitisers are available in the foyer and in every classroom and students will be encouraged to use these before collecting results. They will exit school via the main entrance close to the Upper School Gym, where a hand sanitiser station is also available.

As in previous years, there will be a number of staff, including the Senior Leadership Team, on site to discuss results with your child and to ensure that they are prepared for September. Careers Wales have also been invited to school on that day to provide any extra support with decisions for September where appropriate.

We will make sure that photographs are taken, in socially distanced friendship groups, to mark the occasion and we will make these available to parents.

Students unable to collect results on August 20th.

If students are unable to collect results on the assigned day they will need to give authority for an adult to collect them on their behalf. Authority can be sent by the student via the school mailbox address available on the school website. We can also post results on request, but not until the day of release.

Celebration Presentation – Autumn Term

We had hoped that social distancing rules would have been relaxed enough to allow us to hold a small presentation and celebration for Year 11 students on results day. As this is not the case currently, we have altered our planning and will organise an event in the Autumn Term, hopefully at the end of September or early October . We recognise that it is important to provide a formal celebration for Year 11 in place of the Prom and to say goodbye properly.

Finally

We realise that this has been a challenging time for all our students and families, but particularly for Year 11 in their final examination year. We want August 20th to be a day which allows us to meet as many of the students as possible and to pay tribute to their hard work and time in Ysgol Rhiwabon and to wish them well for the future.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you for your support over the last five years and particularly during this final year. We hope we meet you again in the Autumn. Please feel free to contact us in the future if we can continue to support your child in any way, for example with references or career advice.
